Major work to reinforce the metal structure of the Jacques Cartier Bridge

Dear Neighbour,

The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) is currently working to reinforce the metal structure of the Jacques Cartier Bridge in order to extend its service life until 2070. As we are aware of the impact that this work has on residents and business owners near the bridge, JCCBI established a Good Neighbourly Relations Committee, which meets approximately every two months.

The next meeting of the Good Neighbourly Relations Committee will be held on Tuesday, June 6. This meeting is open to all residents and business owners in the sector and will be held in the evening at the Centre St-Pierre. Representatives from JCCBI, the WSC monitoring team, the Ville-Marie borough and the local police station will be there to give a progress report, present the next work phases, and discuss issues and possible solutions.

At this next meeting, JCCBI will also present the detailed plan for the temporary compensatory measures (fences and flower boxes) that will be implemented this summer until the new public spaces under the bridge are developed for 2020-2021.
