Major work to reinforce the metal structure of the Jacques Cartier Bridge

Dear Neighbour,

The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) thanks you for your tremendous patience and understanding during the vital first phase of the major reinforcement work on the entire metal structure of the Jacques Cartier Bridge. The work site should be dismantled at the end of July, barring any unforeseen circumstances in the coming weeks. We will, however, be doing occasional corrective work between now and the fall.

JCCBI is aware of the effects this type of work has on residents and will maintain its efforts to reduce the potential impact of metal reinforcement work planned in the next phase set for the beginning of October 2017, between Sainte Catherine Street and the concrete frames north of De Maisonneuve Boulevard.

JCCBI is also drawing on exchanges with the Good Neighbourly Relations Committee, which meets every two months or so, to further its understanding of work-related issues and devise hands-on solutions. The next committee meeting is scheduled for the evening of Tuesday, September 26, at Centre St-Pierre. It will be open to all area residents and business owners. Representatives from JCCBI, the WSC monitoring team, the Ville-Marie borough and SPVM Station 22 will be in attendance to discuss the next phases of the project and follow up on the *Spectre de rue* social support program.
