Fireworks magic coming to the Jacques Cartier Bridge with L'International des Feux Loto-Québec!

Longueuil, June 19, 2017 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) is pleased to welcome young and old alike to the Jacques Cartier Bridge to enjoy the 33rd edition of L'International des Feux Loto-Québec from July 1 to August 5. To ensure spectator safety during the fireworks, the bridge will be completely closed in the evening from 8:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. Access will be maintained for emergency services.

Again this summer, Montreal's skyline will be lit up on Saturday and Wednesday evenings as the world's greatest pyrotechnic artists display their talents:

- + Saturday, July 1 – Celebrate Montreal (opening)
- + Saturday, July 8 – Bellissima Sicilia (Italy)
- + Saturday, July 15 – Just Fun (Poland)
- + Wednesday, July 19 – Pyro Rhapsody (Germany)
- + Saturday, July 22 – Evolution of Music (France)
- + Wednesday, July 26 – The Portuguese Odyssey (Portugal)
- + Saturday, July 29 – Gunpowder and Greasepaint (England)
- + Saturday, August 5 – C'est dans le ciel, Serge Fiori and Harmonium (finale)

For the 150th anniversary of Canadian Confederation, a special illumination in honour of Canada will be presented on the Jacques Cartier Bridge on July 1. During the evening, you can even help light up the bridge when you use the hashtag #Canada150.

During the fireworks, JCCBI ambassadors will also be on the bridge to present the new app for the *Stories and Bridges* multimedia tour. Using your smartphone, discover the people, places and events that have forged Montreal's history.
