Incident on the Bonaventure Expressway toward downtown Planned closure this morning to remove a signal structure

Longueuil, June 20, 2017 – Early this morning, The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) temporarily closed the Bonaventure Expressway toward downtown to secure a signal structure spanning the lanes going downtown. Once the structure was stabilized, the traffic lanes were quickly reopened to traffic.

Later this morning after rush hour, and as soon as weather permits, JCCBI will briefly close the Bonaventure Expressway toward downtown between the Champlain Bridge and the exit for Pierre-Dupuy Avenue to remove the signal structure in question. Traffic patrols will be on site to keep traffic away from the area until the structure is removed.
