Jacques Cartier Bridge: Night closures toward Montreal on May 15 and 16

Longueuil, May 10, 2017 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) would like to advise road users that there will be complete night closures on the Jacques Cartier Bridge toward Montreal from Monday, May 15 to Tuesday, May 16 and from Tuesday, May 16 to Wednesday, May 17. These closures are necessary for the installation of moveable barriers for work to reinforce the bridge approaches. Lanes will close starting at around 10:00 p.m., and the bridge will be completely closed toward Montreal between midnight and 4:00 a.m. One lane will be available toward the South Shore and access will be maintained for emergency services.

This work is required as part of the major repairs currently ongoing to extend the service life of the Jacques Cartier Bridge. The closures are required to ensure user and worker safety during the work. JCCBI recommends that users plan their trips accordingly.
