Melocheville Tunnel: Complete closure of the north tube

Longueuil, June 1, 2017 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) would like to notify users that the north tube of the Melocheville Tunnel toward Valleyfield will be completely closed to traffic from Sunday, June 4 (8:00 p.m.) to Monday, June 19 (6:00 a.m.), for waterproofing work. During the work, traffic will alternate in direction in the south tube toward Beauharnois. Flaggers will be on site 24 hours a day to ensure user safety and the passage of cyclists and pedestrians.

The purpose of the major repair work is to reinforce the concrete structure and enhance security devices. The repair work will finish in spring 2017.
