Melocheville Tunnel: Night closures in alternance in north and south tubes from July 23 to 28

Longueuil, July 20, 2017 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) would like to advise users that alternating night closures of north and south tubes in the Melocheville Tunnel are planned from Sunday, July 23 to Friday, July 28 for work to inspect lighting fixtures and to perform pavement repairs. During the work, alternating traffic, in both direction, will be ensure by flaggers and the passage of cyclists and pedestrians will be possible on the north tube sidewalk.

Restriction details

- + **Complete closure of the north tube toward Melocheville, with alternating traffic in the south tube**
 - Sunday, July 23 (8:00 p.m.) to Monday, July 24 (6:00 a.m.)
 - Tuesday, July 25 (8:00 p.m.) to Wednesday, July 26 (6:00 a.m.)
 - Thursday, July 27 (8:00 p.m.) to Friday, July 28 (6:00 a.m.)
- + **Complete closure of the south tube toward Beauharnois, with alternating traffic in the north tube**
 - Monday, July 24 (8:00 p.m.) to Tuesday, July 25 (6:00 a.m.)
 - Wednesday, July 26 (8:00 p.m.) to Thursday, July 27 (6:00 a.m.)

These closures are required to ensure user and worker safety during the work.
