**Longueuil, May 4, 2017** – To celebrate Montreal's 375th anniversary and the 150th anniversary of Canadian Confederation, The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) is pleased to invite you to the inauguration of the illumination of the Jacques Cartier Bridge on Wednesday, May 17. Come watch this unique event that will light up the night!

To ensure safety, the Jacques Cartier Bridge and multipurpose path and sidewalk will be completely closed during the evening of May 17. Access will be maintained for emergency services. JCCBI recommends that users plan their trips accordingly.

### Closure details – May 17

- + Complete closure of the Jacques Cartier Bridge from 9:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m.
- + Gradual lane closures starting at 8:30 p.m.
- + Gradual lane reopening after the special light show; complete reopening of the bridge as of 10:30 p.m.
