Champlain Bridge: Partial closure of René-Lévesque Blvd. to L'Île-des-Sœurs

Longueuil, June 23, 2017 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) would like to advise users that René-Lévesque Boulevard will be temporarily closed to traffic under the Champlain Bridge to L'Île-des-Sœurs for reinforcement work and the installation of a temporary work platform. The work will take place at night during the week for two weeks.

Closure details

- + **Complete closure of René-Lévesque Boulevard in both directions** under the Champlain Bridge from Wednesday, June 28 to Friday, June 30, and from Monday, July 3 to Friday, July 7, and on Monday, July 10 from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

This work is part of the major repair program for the Champlain Bridge to ensure user safety until the new Champlain Bridge opens.

Note that this work could be postponed because of unsuitable weather conditions.
