of the Jacques Cartier Bridge

The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) is currently working to reinforce the metal structure of the Jacques Cartier Bridge in order to extend the service life of this Montreal icon.

As we are aware of the impact that this work has on residents and merchants near the bridge, JCCBI will start a Good Neighbourly Relations Committee on Tuesday, January 31 to open a dialogue and find solutions to ensure the work has the least possible impact on the neighbourhood.

This meeting will be held in the evening at the Centre St-Pierre and is open to all residents and business owners in the sector. Representatives from JCCBI, the WSC monitoring team, and the Ville-Marie borough will attend the meeting.

The Good Neighbourly Relations Committee will hold a meeting about once every two months to provide updates on the work, inform you of the next work phases, and discuss issues and possible solutions.
