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SUBSECTION 6.11 GENERAL

6.11.1 SCOPE

- 6.11.1.1 This Section 6 *Standard Technical Conditions* of the Tender Documents consolidates some of the **Owner's** standard technical requirements that form an integral part of this Contract. All the technical requirements set out in this Section shall be reviewed carefully and in close relation with the specific technical requirements of the Contract indicated on the drawings and in Section 4 *Special Technical Conditions* of the specifications.
- 6.11.1.2 In case of conflict or discrepancy between the provisions of this Section 6 *Standard Technical Conditions* and those of Section 4 *Special Technical Conditions*, the requirements of Section 4 shall prevail as provided in Article 5.6 *Order of Precedence*.
- 6.11.1.3 The **Owner's** standard technical requirements may be subject to changes from time to time. Consequently, the **Contractor** shall carefully review the standard technical requirements that are part of these specifications, even if the **Contractor** is already familiar with the **Owner's** standard technical requirements.

6.11.2 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 6.11.2.1 At all times, the **Contractor** shall ensure the structural integrity of any structures affected by its work.
- 6.11.2.2 The **Contractor** shall solely assume full responsibility for the work methods and sequences thereby selected, including all calculations, in the case where it uses all or part of the methods and sequences indicated on the drawings of this Contract.
- 6.11.2.3 The **Contractor** shall, at all times, validate all dimensions, measurements and information needed to ensure the precision and accuracy of its work, either from the reference drawings or the Contract drawings.

6.11.3 REFERENCE STANDARDS

- 6.11.3.1 For the purposes of carrying out the work and notwithstanding the version of the standards prescribed in this Section 6 *Standard Technical Conditions*, but subject to Section 4 *Special Technical Conditions*, the applicable versions of the standards will be those in effect on the date of issuance of the Call for Tenders. However, should a new version of a standard be published after the date of issuance of the Call for Tenders, the parties may agree to apply this new standard. The **Contractor** shall notify the Engineer that it intends on using a new version of a standard at least fourteen (14) days prior to the start of manufacturing and/or on worksite and shall obtain the latter's authorization before starting the work.
