Bonaventure Expressway: Complete closure of Exit 2 and lane closures toward downtown on April 26-27

Longueuil, April 24, 2019 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) wishes to advise users that a complete closure of Exit 2 (Pierre Dupuy Ave./Casino) of the Bonaventure Expy., toward downtown, is planned on April 26 and 27 for excavation work related to the installation of fiber optics. During this work, lane closures are also planned toward downtown. A detour via the local network will be in place (see attached map).

Closure details:

- + Complete closure of Exit 2 (Pierre Dupuy Ave./Casino) of the Bonaventure Expy., toward downtown, from Friday, April 26 10 p.m. to Saturday, April 27 3 p.m.
- + Closure of two (2) of the three (3) lanes of the Bonaventure Hwy. toward downtown, from Friday, April 26 10 p.m. to Saturday, April 27 3 p.m.
- + Closure of a portion of the Chemin des Moulins toward the Champlain Bridge, on Saturday, April 27 from 5 a.m. to 7 p.m.

These closures are required to ensure user and worker safety during the work. Note that this work could be postponed because of unsuitable weather conditions.
