

Honoré Mercier Bridge: night closures of one lane toward the South shore on May 5 and 6 and toward Montreal on May 7 and 8

Longueuil, May 3, 2019 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) would like to advise road users that one lane will be closed at night on the Honoré Mercier Bridge toward the South Shore, on May 5 and 6, and toward Montreal on May 7 and 8, for inspection work.

Closure details

- From Sunday, May 5, to Monday, May 6
 - Only 1 lane available toward the South Shore on the bridge, between 9:00 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- From Monday, May 6, to Tuesday, May 7
 - Only 1 lane available toward the South Shore on the bridge, between 9:00 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- From Tuesday, May 7, to Wednesday, May 8
 - Only 1 lane available toward Montreal on the bridge, between 9:00 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- From Wednesday, May 8, to Thursday, May 9
 - Only 1 lane available toward Montreal on the bridge, between 9:00 p.m. and 5 a.m.

These planned closures are required to ensure worker safety during the work.
