The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) is currently preparing the Champlain Bridge deconstruction project. We are therefore inviting you to our upcoming **Information Days** so that you can learn more about the project and discuss its components with our experts.

The Champlain Bridge has reached the end of its service life and will be deconstructed starting in 2020 using a **sustainable development** approach. This major project, which will last approximately three years, consists of several components, including **environmental protection, material reuse, research and development**, and “**Héritage Champlain**,” a project to redevelop the shoreline around the original bridge and the Champlain Bridge Estacade for recreational and commemorative purposes.

During the **Information Days**, JCCBI representatives will inform you of measures to mitigate the project’s impact on the local population.
