Several hindrances toward the Samuel De Champlain Bridge starting on July 19

Longueuil, July 17, 2019 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) wishes to inform road users that several closures will take place toward the Samuel De Champlain Bridge starting on July 19, to carry out structural repairs and paving.

Details of the closure

- + **Complete closure of Exit 3 (Carrie-Derick) and Des Moulins Road toward the Samuel De Champlain Bridge**, from Friday, July 19 midnight to Saturday, July 20 9 a.m. A detour via the local network will be in place.
- + **Complete closure of the Bonaventure Expressway toward the Samuel De Champlain Bridge between Wellington St. and Exit 3 (Carrie-Derick)**, from Monday, July 22 10 p.m. to Tuesday, July 23 5 a.m. A detour via the local network will be in place (see attached map).
- + **Long-term complete closure of Exit 2 (Pierre-Dupuy Ave./Port of Montréal) toward the Samuel De Champlain Bridge**, from Tuesday, July 23 to mid-September. A new detour via the local network will be in place (see attached map).

Note that this work could be postponed because of unsuitable weather conditions.
