## **Jacques Cartier Bridge: Complete closure of access ramps to Hwy. 132 during the night of October 4 to 5**

**Longueuil, October 2, 2019** – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) wishes to advise road users that the access ramps to Hwy. 132 will be completely closed during the night of October 4 to 5 for pavement marking work. A detour via the local network will be set up (see enclosed maps).

### **Closure details**

#### **Saturday, October 5 (night from Friday to Saturday)**

- + Complete closure of the bridge's exit ramp to Hwy. 132, from Saturday, October 5 (00:30 a.m.) to (6:00 a.m.) **Detour map 1**
- + Complete closure of Hwy. 134 access ramp to Hwy. 132, from Saturday, October 5 (00:30 a.m.) to (6:00 a.m.) **Detour map 2 or optional itinerary map 3**

These planned closures during the work are required to ensure user and worker safety. JCCBI recommends that users plan their trips accordingly. Note that this work could be postponed due to unsuitable weather conditions.
